Annotations: A book entry with an `author` and an `editor`.

Annotations: A book entry with a `translator` field.

### Aristotle: Poetics aristotle:poetics

Annotations: A book entry with an `author` and an `editor` as well as a `series` field.

### Aristotle: Rhetoric aristotle:rhetoric

Annotations: This is a **periodical** entry with an **issn** field.

Annotations: A **book** entry with 4 authors and an **edition** field. By default, long **author** and **editor** lists are automatically truncated. This is configurable.

Annotations: This is an **online** entry. The URL, which is given in the **url** field, is transformed into a clickable link if **hyperref** support has been enabled. Note the format of the **urldate** field (yyyy-mm-dd) in the database file. Also note the **label** field which may be used as a fallback by citation styles which need an **author** and/or a **year**.

to be cited and alphabetized by title even though there is an editor. In addition to that, we want the title to be alphabetized under ‘E’ rather than ‘T’. Also note the `label` field which is provided for author-year citation styles.
